Area of Practice: Family Practice (Hagerstown, MD)

Termination of probationary terms and conditions imposed by the Final Decision and Order dated September 9, 2011. The physician has complied with the terms and conditions precedent. Date of Action: May 3, 2013

Area of Practice: Anesthesiology (Washington, DC)

Suspension for a minimum of six months with terms and conditions. If Suspension is terminated, Probation for a minimum of five years with terms and conditions. Reprimand; Probation for a minimum of two years with terms and conditions. The physician must terminate her chronic pain management practice. The physician may prescribe CDS for a period of three days for an acute condition and may prescribe CDS medications indicated for Attention Deficit Disorder in dosages not to exceed recommended amounts.
